






Seeing as it's 9.30pm by the time this is being written, it is probably goin to be short.

Dean takes pictures of the sunrise over






Lester 'n' Danny have a cool beverage, no wonder they can't catch fish, they're hot by 8am.

Most team were home at a reasonable our with The Three Yahoo's


in just before 4.30, giving everybody on the dock time to be set up.
